(Subject to change)

Wednesday, Apr. 18th: Depart from JFK at 6:00 p.m.

Thursday, Apr. 19th: Arrive at noon; transfer to Le Meridien Hotel in Giza. Snack on the bus, dinner together, then rest from the long flight. (D)

Friday, Apr. 20th: Enjoy a camel ride on the Giza plateau; discover its three great pyramids, the queen's pyramids, Isis Temple, Sphinx, Valley Temple, and panoramic view. Visit an oil and perfume shop, and rest at the hotel before the private meditation time in the Great Pyramid. Dinner and overnight at Le Meridien Hotel. (BLD)

Saturday, Apr. 21st: After checkout, tour the magnificent Egyptian Museum in Cairo, lunch at a local restaurant, and visit the Khan el Khalili market. Fly to Luxor in the evening. Overnight at the Sonesta St. George Hotel. (BLD)

Sunday, Apr. 22nd: Enjoy a meeting with your tour leader; the rest of the morning is at leisure. Visit a papyrus shop after lunch. In the evening, watch the Karnak sound-and-light show. Overnight at the Sonesta St. George Hotel. (BLD)

Monday, Apr. 23rd: Check out of the Luxor Hotel and tour the Valley of the Kings. Here you will visit the beautifully painted tombs, the temple of Hatshepsut (the famous female pharaoh), Memnon colossi, and an alabaster shop. Check-in for the Nile cruise and enjoy a free afternoon. In the evening, visit the beautiful Luxor temple, laid out in the pattern of the human body. (BLD)

Tuesday, April 24th: Visit the mammoth Karnak Temple (over sixty acres, largest temple in ancient Egypt). Enjoy a free afternoon on the Nile as the group sails to Edfu. (BLD)

Wednesday, Apr. 25th: Visit Edfu Temple and Kom Ombo. (BLD)

Thursday, Apr. 26th: Arrive in beautiful Aswan. Visit Philae temple in the morning; in the afternoon, visit Elephantine Island, the local museum, and Khunom Temple via felucca boats (native sailboats). (BLD)

Friday, Apr. 27th: Fly from Aswan to Abu Simbel in the morning. Visit the magnificent temple on Lake Nasser. Return to Cairo around 5:00 p.m. and check-in to the Meridien Pyramid Hotel in Cairo. (BLD)

Saturday, Apr. 28th: Tour Sakkara, including Mere Ruka's tomb, with its beautiful painted walls; Teti's Pyramid, with its ancient text and starry ceiling; the Jubilee Temple of Pharaoh Djoser; then on to Dahsfur, with its three amazing pyramids: the Red, "Bent," and Black Pyramids. After lunch in Sakkara, visit a carpet factory, and enjoy some free time before dinner in an authentic Egyptian home. Overnight at Le Meridien Hotel. (BLD)

Sunday, Apr. 29th: Fly to JFK from Cairo; Arrival in JFK at 3:30 p.m. (B)
