Colon Hydrotherapy *Theory & Experiential*

Edgar Cayce called a colonic an “internal bath” which cleanses mucus and plaque off the colon walls, stimulates the peristaltic muscle tone, and is a systemic detox of the blood, lymph and liver. It is a profound hydrotherapy that also helps release various toxins from the body.

Colon Hydrotherapy Theory consists of the study of colonic details, 25 hours of anatomy and physiology and required reading of *Edgar Cayce’s Guide to Colon Care* by Sandra Duggan, RN, BS, with an open book test on all three areas.

In the six-day *Colon Hydrotherapy Experiential* class, you will receive one colonic from another student, observe 15 colonics and give seven supervised colonics. There will be 11 theory classes, independent library study and a written exam on material learned during the week.
