THE FIRST TEN MINUTES AFTER DEATH: Hugh Lynn Cayce

The concepts of time and space can be most confusing for us. Let's look, then, at another area of this transition, again from the readings, as to how long death may take:

“... many an individual has remained in that called death for what ye call years without realizing it was dead!” (1472-2)

Now this is a rather disturbing idea and at first you may negate it; you may insist that God couldn't let that kind of thing happen. We can't be that lonely; we can't be that closed off. But we only have to turn around and look at ourselves in the present to understand exactly what this reading is talking about. We build the separation from each other in this life, and we close ourselves off with our masks and our confusing patterns. If we cannot communicate, one with another, even with those we reach out to and love, how can we expect to do

so in this transition? We say, “It all will be better,” but mind is the builder and there is this transition state. We have many examples from the readings on this.

“The feelings, the desires for what ye call appetites are changed, or not aware at all. The ability to communicate is that which usually disturbs or worries others. Then, as to say how long—that depends upon the entity. For, as has been given, the psychic forces of an entity are **CONSTANTLY** active—whether the soul-entity is aware of same or not. Hence as has been the experience of many, these become as individual as individualities or personalities are themselves.” (1472-2)

“In the passage the entity becomes conscious, or the recognition of

being in a fourth or higher dimensional plane takes place, much in the same way as the consciousness is gained in the material.” (5749-3)

In other words, you are born into that plane just as you are born into this one. You are conscious when you come in as a child, and you can even go back in regression and know exactly what you were thinking when you came in as a child. This has been done for a long time. The consciousness, not physical consciousness, but consciousness of the actual, other self—the higher self—comes in here. We are always recording, right from the moment of birth—perhaps even before birth, in the embryo state. We are remembering, building, experiencing, but we are not aware of it. So in this death transition we move in, we are building. We may not be consciously aware at the moment of that transition, we may not realize that we are dead; but there is no time here, so this transition takes place in an interesting fashion. In a number of places this was pointed out in the readings.

“In the separation of the soul and spirit from an earthly abode, each enter the spirit realm. When the entity has fully completed its separation, it goes to that force through

which the entity merits in the action upon the earth's plane, and in the various spheres, or in the various elements, as has been prepared for its (the spiritual entity) development, so the sojourn is taken, until the entity is ready for again manifesting through the flesh that development attained in the spiritual entity, for the will MUST be made one with the Father, that we may enter into that realm of the blessed, for, as has been given, only the true, the perfect, may see God, and we MUST be one with Him.” (294-15)

Now, Cayce is describing the mental state that we prepare for ourselves. We move into that state of consciousness by the way we think and by what we are trying to satisfy. We are so closely tied to the earth that we don't even realize for a little while that we are dead, but in no time, then, we begin to awaken. It may be a sleep, like a sleeping child, and later an awakening. The child is recording all the time, every word, every impression, but it is not conscious and doesn't remember; however, the information can be recalled. We've got a tape recorder going, not only in this plane but in the other. So this transition is like a birth here, in this sense, and people greet and prepare the way for us.
