My Unusual Ability

By Edgar Cayce with Judith Stevens

“As I am going into this psychic state, or whatever it may be termed, someone suggests to me that I will hear them . . . will speak to them. They suggest to me that I will see the party that they want me to [help], telling me just where the party is at that time. I do not have to know anything of the [person] beforehand.”

“The first thing I ever tried was how to regain my voice. That worked. The man who first found [I could do this] was not in very good health himself . . . and wanted to try it. He did and it worked wonders for him. He continued to try [it] on such cases as seemed hopeless, [benefitting many.]”

“[At first] I couldn't believe it.”

Others told Mr. Cayce how they were greatly helped by him in this so-called “sleep state” and he concluded that it was a gift from God to be used for the good of others. He vowed that if even one person was harmed by the information that flowed through him, that he would never give another “reading.”

He began to notice a difference in how

he felt afterwards when he was asked to “read for the sick,” as opposed to when he was asked to locate lost articles. He asked himself, “What makes the difference?”

“I was and am compelled to come back, when judging these things to two Divine laws. ‘Any tree, any man, any work, is known by its fruit.’ [Matthew 12:33]. [And] ‘Whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap.’” [Galatians 6:7]

“As I said at first, I could not ‘get’ what all of this meant. How could I, not a doctor, never having studied even psychology or any of the other things . . . tell when in this condition, what would aid, if property taken? I did not know, and do not know even now, but can anyone tell me how the phonograph needle takes the music from the record, or how the radio picks the messages out of the air? But it does . . . So, with all psychic force, properly attuned, properly adjusted, you receive definite good. Out of tune, the human mind is capable of using it to their own destruction. How are we to judge that which is true from that which is false?”

He determined that those looking for “material things, sensational things,” got them, but this had a detrimental effect on Mr. Cayce’s health. He considered giving up “the Work” entirely. When he next “attempted to assist a man in his home town, the report was taken up by a medical man and presented to one of

the research societies . . . and I was finally persuaded to go into the work and give my whole time to it.”

“For a while, all was well. There were a great many people benefitted, a great many people cured. Then there [again] crept in the desire to make money, and again the desire to put on the sensational came to those in charge of the work, and the work began to fail.” Why? “Because the actions of those about me were not in keeping with that still small voice within.”

When Mrs. Cayce fell ill, her doctor told Mr. Cayce, “If there’s anything in that monkey business you’re doing, [you] better try it.”

“It was tried, but with a different spirit within me. The results were far beyond what anyone had ever dreamed.” Mr. Cayce then “laid aside” the work of giving readings and went back to [his] picture making [photography]. But [the Work] would not rest. “When something gives ease and comfort to our physical bodies, and our loved ones, it becomes to us something worthwhile, and no matter what others may say, to us, it is the REAL thing.” Mr. Cayce did as the readings suggested, and Mrs. Cayce, his helpmeet, became the trusted conductor of the readings, from this time forward, aiding thousands of seekers, and allowing “the Work” to proceed with integrity.
