Dear Prayer Healing Friends,

Hugh Lynn Cayce's article, "The Ideals and Purposes of the A.R.E." (January, 1978, *The A.R.E. Journal*), recounts how Tom Sugrue, author of *There Is a River*, spoke at the 1941 A.R.E. Congress when Edgar Cayce was still alive.

"We have taken quite a beating since 1929," he said. [He was referring to the Great Depression and the loss of the Cayce Hospital.] "Some of us are willing to admit that it is necessary not only to know the truth, but to practice it."

Fast-forward to 1977: Members of A.R.E.'s Long-Range Planning Committee and Board of Trustees (Edgar Cayce Foundation) committed to paper the purpose of the organization as they saw it. It seems timely to share some of the thoughts of the "pioneers" as we move into this new phase of what Mr. Cayce called "the Work."

Let's bring the best of the past into our present and future, shall we?

A LOOK AT A.R.E.'S SPIRITUAL IDEALS AND PURPOSES

By Hugh Lynn Cayce with Judith Stevens

In 1945, a member of the Board of Trustees wrote: ". . . the basic object of the Association is: To awaken and direct the Individual to use constructively the divine forces within himself [or herself]—for personal and universal good."

In 1977, Board members expressed A.R.E.'s purpose in this way: "To present all seekers with practical suggestions as to how they can better understand and relate to themselves, to their universe and to other people."

Another wrote: ". . . as members of an organization that has its ideals in service to its fellow [humans], the purpose of the A.R.E. is to ' . . . make manifest the love of God and [humankind]—our relation to one another and our relation to God.'" (taken from reading 254-42 that Hugh Lynn had inscribed over the doorway of A.R.E.'s new Library/Conference Center when it opened in 1975.)

Robert Adriance, Board member and author of *Highlights from the Work Readings*, felt we should awaken first, individuals, then groups, then masses of people to the truth of who we are: "a part of God, living in eternity, who by seeking for attunement through prayer, study, and meditation may be refined in [our] mental, physical, and spiritual bodies into harmony with the Christ Consciousness and with other beings, bringing into the earth a new era of understanding, cooperation and service, and a flowering of the spirit."

Work reading 254-56 advised the newly forming A.R.E. to "[first] set its ideals," then ideas, purposes and aims, and that these should be "tried, tested, manifested" in the lives of each person who "subscribes" to such an organization, so that others know that a purpose, an aim, has been set.

Work Reading 254-92 simplifies that “ . . . there is only one ideal! . . . as it is set forth in the Christ Consciousness as exemplified by Jesus.” The Universal Christ Consciousness spiritual Ideal also contains the mental ideal and the physical ideal. The Work Readings direct us to the “fruits of the spirit” and encourage those in the Work to use these helpful attitudes when dealing with everyone.

Hugh Lynn suggested that we “should employ the fruits of the spirits in [our] attitudes toward all.” *He said we should think of these “fruits” as our “mental ideals.”* [my italics] What are the fruits of the spirit? More than 20 are given in the readings, including love, gentleness, kindness, peace, hope, joy, patience, understanding, mercy, humility, justice, fellowship, truth, persistence, faith, goodness, meekness, obedience, harmony, consistency in acts and speech, forgiveness, and grace.

Hugh Lynn thought reading 281-17 sets forth the physical ideal of the A.R.E.: “ . . . an organization that has its ideals in being

of a service to its fellow [humans]. When I began work at A.R.E. in 1968, Retired Naval Commander Harold Allen, then head of A.R.E. Press, told me that A.R.E. was “first and foremost a service organization” that was supported by its members, our small printing press, bookstore, and the conferences being organized at HQ and around the world. In other words, we were a service organization first, and a business secondarily.

To summarize, then, our ideals are as follows:

Our **SPIRITUAL IDEAL** The Universal Christ Consciousness

Our **MENTAL IDEAL** Exemplifying the fruits of the Spirit

Our **PHYSICAL IDEAL** Being of service to all

A.R.E.’s PURPOSE, then, is to make manifest the love of God and all humankind, our relations with one another, and our relationship to God, in a time that desperately needs all three. As our new CEO says, “How are we doing?”
